Step 1: Login

Logging in to the EJOT License Portal is divided into two steps (two-factor authentication). In the first step, you must enter your user name (followed by @ejot.com) and password. After entering this data, you will be forwarded to the second step. Here you can choose your second factor. You can choose between a call, a code via SMS or the usage of an authenticator app.

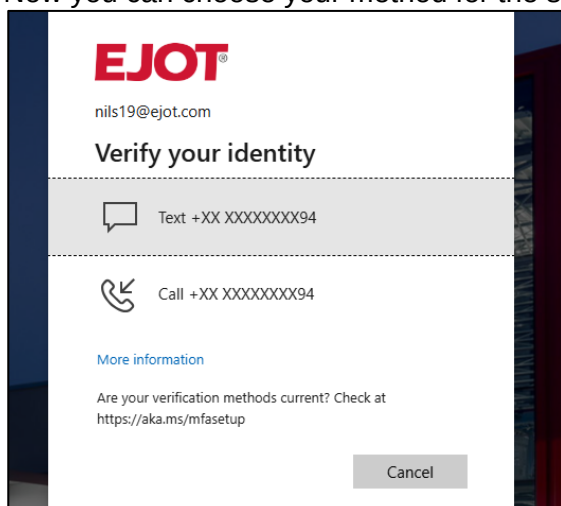
These two steps are necessary to ensure that only authorized persons have access to EJOT resources.

1. Open a new window in your browser and navigate to <https://licensing.ejot.com>.
2. Enter the EJOT user name followed by @ejot.com and click next.



3. Enter your password and click on **“Sign in”**.

4. Now you can choose your method for the second factor:

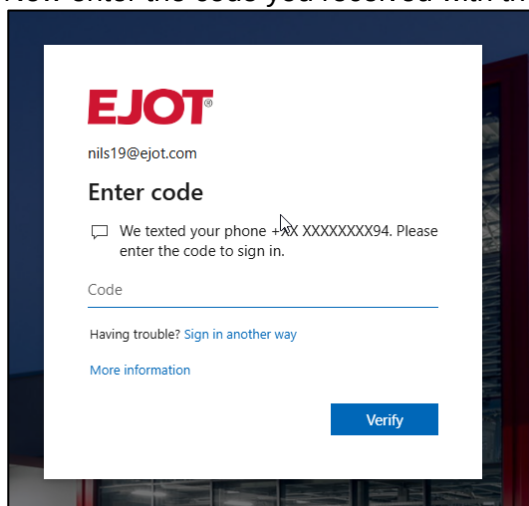

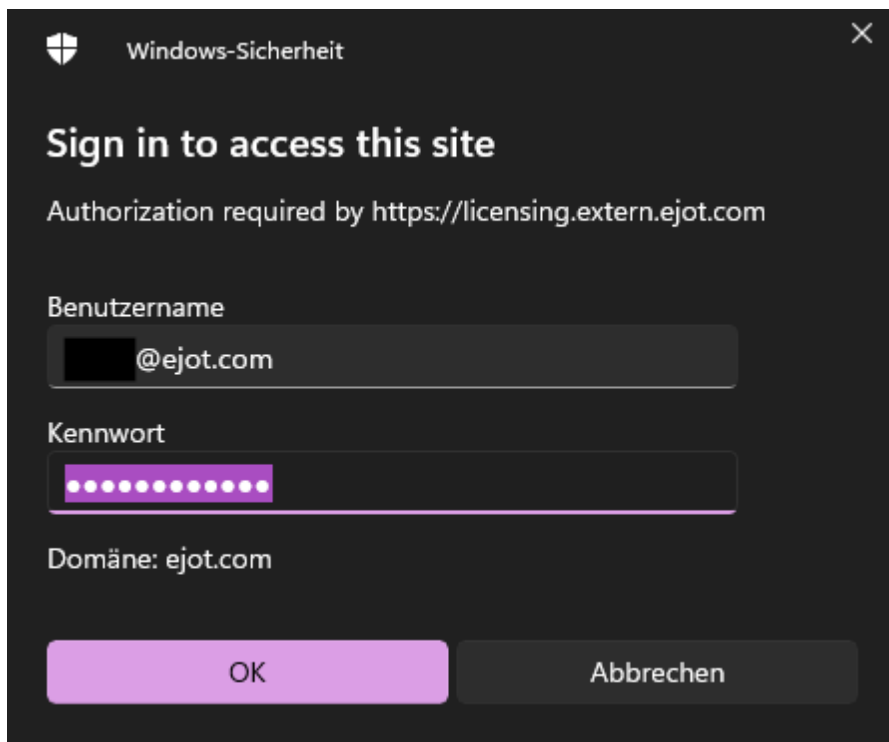
